#### NOTES ON MESSIAH

All special music in today's service was composed by George Frideric Handel (1685-1759). All choral selections are from his famous oratorio Messiah. Composed in the summer of 1741, Messiah premiered in Dublin in April of 1742 to great acclaim. Later it was one of the first large-scale works performed in the United States. In 1770 the work was premiered in New York City and then followed by the first complete performance in Boston in 1818.

The text was selected and organized by Charles Jennens, an English patron of the arts and close friend of Handel, from the King James Bible and the Book of Common Prayer.

Messiah is divided into three distinctive sections. Part I deals with the prophecy and birth of the Christ through Old Testament verses; Part II reflects on the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ while Part III anticipates the redemption of the world through faith.

Handel is considered the "Father of the English Concerto" and wrote a number of organ concertos to be played between the vocal sections of Messiah. Today two movements from one of his many concertos are used as the Prelude and the Postlude.
